Ecology - Leslie Cunningham

Lake was treated last week – algae and underwater plants

Email from Solitude did not need to use as much chemical as anticipated for the plants – they adjusted the fee to \$2,100 total

Contract with Solitude is through June 2021 - We need to look into other providers over the winter.

Lake water reports clean and suitable for swimming –

Received the fish report - will forward to all and have Bob put on website

Few dead carp -

Large carp association member called board to have removed (2 to 2 ½ feet long)

# Property Committee - Jaime Macsata

Additional Tree Removal needed on the Cottage Road back lot and Upper Cottage Road Beach (Across from Buck's House)

Austin Tree Removal was not interested in removing the tree in the lot next to Travis's house only interested only in removing the tree across from Wayne's Buck

\$7,500 in maintenance budget - \$5,300 requesting to be used for tree removal

George suggested that we put out to quote to remove both trees suggested 3 quotes – Steve Harz will reach out to get quotes

Leslie will meet with George and Steve to identify trees –
